

- Waste Mgmt. is putting together plans for a Clean Community Event on April 24th at the Road Commission and a Fall event at the Granger facility on Wood Street October 9th. This is dependent on control of COVID at that time.
- The County board approved a facility HVAC study to improve air quality and improved efficiency. The effort to reduce COVID transmission was the impetus, but other benefits are expected.
- County extended the Emergency Declaration for another 30 days; meetings, where feasible, will continue to be held virtually.

2. Zoning Administrator's Report: Board members briefly discussed Ms. Foster's November report. S. Schafer stated the Planning Commission met on December 7th, and Tammy Foster attended virtually. The Commission spoke about possibly amending/changing the Zoning Ordinance. However, it will be tabled until their March meeting, to rediscuss at that time.

3. Old Fire Hall Use for Fowler Athletics: V. Feldpausch reported the Fowler football coach contacted him regarding the use of the south side of the township hall, as a training room for FHS athletes, during school construction/renovation. It was decided to table this discussion until the January meeting.


