<u>Additions or Correction to Agenda/Approval of Agenda:</u> E. Marvel moved, supported by S. Schafer to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

<u>Approval of Bills:</u> There was lengthy discussion regarding the fire department bills from the Main Street fire in December. **E. Marvel moved, supported by A. Schafer to approve the payment of \$2562.33** from the General Fund and \$3867.32 from the Fire Department fund. E. Marvel noted her motion includes billing property owners for expenses incurred from December fire. Motion carried.

REPORTS:

<u>Fire Dept:</u> V. Feldpausch stated since the Main Street fire, two additional fire fighters have applied with Dallas Twp. Fire & Rescue. There are currently twenty-eight (28) fire fighters; six (6) carry gear; also, discussion followed regarding wild land fire gear.

<u>Clerk:</u> T. Koenigsknecht completed the 4th quarter payroll including the Planning Commission; worked on balancing 941 payroll reports with W2 amounts; and going through records over 7 years old and shredding.

<u>Treasurer:</u> A. Schafer stated 57% or \$652,569.86 collected thus far for winter taxes; and C. Simon land division issue resolved.

<u>Supervisor:</u> V. Feldpausch attended the Clinton Ambulance board meeting; discussed Greenbush Twp. Fire Dept request; met with Bengal Supervisor and Clerk regarding billing issues;

OLD BUSINESS:

1. <u>Wind Turbines:</u> No news.

2. <u>Zoning Enforcement with Bengal Township:</u> V. Feldpausch stated 3 resumes were received for this position and interviews will be forthcoming. Also, he will contact Bengal Twp. to check time and place of interview.

3. <u>Medical Marihuana Zoning</u>: Clinton County can't make decision to enforce this until all townships opt out.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. <u>County Commissioner Report</u>: Commissioner Pohl stated RAVE 9-1-1 has been going well; spoke about Peninsula Fiber Optic interconnective internet service; and the new medical examiner is Dr. David Minnick.

2. Zoning Administrator's Report: There was a short discussion regarding Tammy Foster's activity report.

3. <u>C.A.A.S.A. Capital Budget & Operating Budget Approval:</u> There was discussion regarding the current \$3 per capita amount and an increase to \$6 per capita by 2023. S. Schafer moved, supported by T. Koenigsknecht to approve the C.A.A.S.A. Capital Budget & Operating Budget Approval. Motion carried.

4. MTA Conference Approval: E. Marvel moved, supported by A. Schafer to approve the Dallas Township Board members to attend the MTA Conference from April 1 - 4, 2019 in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Motion carried.

5. Billing Clerk Position: There was discussion regarding the current Billing Clerk stepping down effective April 1, 2019. This will be discussed at the February meeting.
