The Dallas Township Planning Commission was open to hear public comment on the Special Use Permit for the cell tower on west Walker Rd.

Chairman Farley went over the Public Hearing Format. American Tower Wireless Communication's attorney Mr. David Tracy had joined the commission by phone to field any questions concerning the tower. Commission members were allowed to ask questions of Mr. Tracy. Mr. Tracy then talked about test run on the tower and everything seemed to meet all standards required. The lease currently goes to 2050. The last national test was in 2018. A test is conducted every three years to meet the standards of national, state, and county/township. Mr. Tracy will email Tammy Foster (Ziemnick Foster Engineering, LLC) on what was being done at the base of the support cables the week of Sept. 7th 2020. Questions were asked about the permit for that time work being done, did they need a permit or not. Mr. Tracy did state that a bond for \$50,000.00 was applied for, for the removal or decommission or the towner. The last compliance report was in 2018.

No public comments

After meeting with Mr. Tracy, several questions for Tammy Foster about requirements and annual reporting were explained. Tammy then explained the ordinance and zoning that Dallas Planning Commission has adopted and how it pertains to cell towers and maintenance of those towers.

"I move that the Dallas Township Planning Commission recommend approval of SUP2020-001 to the Township Board, for the American Tower Delaware Corporation Wireless Communication Tower Facility's Special Use Permit located on parcel #:040-001-300-015-052, for the following reasons:

- 1. The request meets the general standards for Special Use Permit found in Section 12.05 of the Dallas Township Zoning Ordinance.
- 2. The request meets the specific standards for Wireless Communication Towers and Facilities found in Article 9 of the Dallas Township Zoning Ordinance.

Subject to the following stipulations:

- A. Approval of the site plan by Dallas Township Planning Commission as submitted concurrently with the Special Use Permit application.
- B. The applicant shall provide a program for continued inspections and maintenance of the site compound, driveway and lease area. The inspection and maintenance program shall provide statements of annual inspection and every 3 years a structural analysis report be performed and be submitted to the Township for review.
- C. A surety bond is to be established in the amount of \$75,000 for the removal of the facility in the event that the development be abandoned for a period of more than six (6) months.
- D. The permit holder shall comply with all State, County, and other governmental regulations relative to the development of the petitioned special land use, as well as comply with the

rules and requirements of the Clinton County Drain Commissioner (CCDC), Clinton County Road Commission (CCRC), Mid-Michigan District Health Department (MMDHD), Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), and the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE), as they are required to be adhered to upon the subject property.

- E. The uses as described in this petition are the only uses permitted by the Special Use Permit.
- F. The expiration date of the Special Use Permit is 5yrs. Or 2025 or from the date of The Dallas Township meeting were its approved.

A roll call vote was unanimous.
